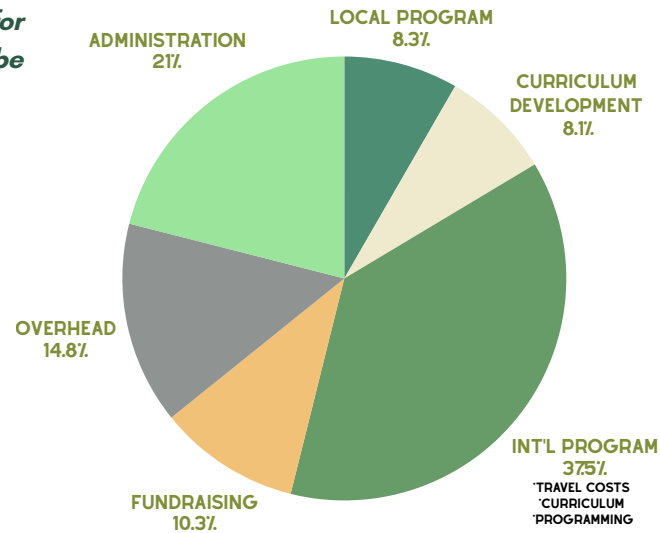
OPERATING BUDGET:
